- Collaborate with Human Resources between employee representative groups, management and employees to develop a **sustainable plant CI culture**.
- Support achievement of the plant conversion cost targets and identify cost reduction opportunities.
- Develop a **CI road map** and an annual master plan for the entire plant facility and provide assistance for the execution (e.g., facilitation, coordination, visualisation, communication, and celebration) of the road map.
- Initiate and **support training and induction programs** by using existing tools from the CI toolbox (e.g., team building, facilitation, Waterfall, QCDSM, Kaizen / Changeover) to ensure all employees understand the concept of CI.
- Build a close **partnership** with the Center of Excellence functions (Organisation Organise annual meetings with all plant functions to share CI status, define next steps in order to raise the performance bar, review plans to deliver sustainable cost reduction and develop plans to drive towards a CI plant culture.
- Ensure efficient use of **global communication platforms** (e.g., intranet, CI symposium, external sources) to fill the local pipeline with new ideas and best practices, as well as providing the plant network with local CI success stories and initiatives.
- Provide and apply valuable and transferable **smart ideas** to and from the Smart Idea Library of the CI page.
- **Track and report progress** on conversion productivity in partnership with local Finance using tools such as the Project Tracking System (PTS / PI).
- **Collaborate** within the Region and CI Network as well as with local CI Managers from other plants across categories and countries in order to communicate the global bench marking methodology. Support the Region and the CI Network on bench marking best practice database.
